At the conclusion of the project SS-A, DMMA will have four important documents: 1) "As-Is" and "To-Be" MITA maturity levels for the 79 MITA business processes, 2) a MITA transition plan that incorporates DMMA's strategic MITA vision, 3) the MITA SS-A documentation necessary to submit an Implementation Advance Planning Document to CMS, and 4) an RFP for the MMIS enhancement procurement.
